

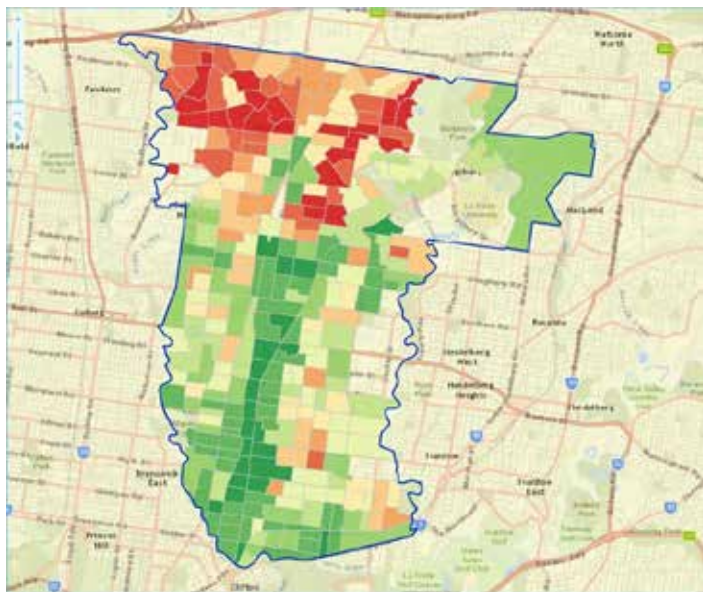
Community Indicators Victoria
